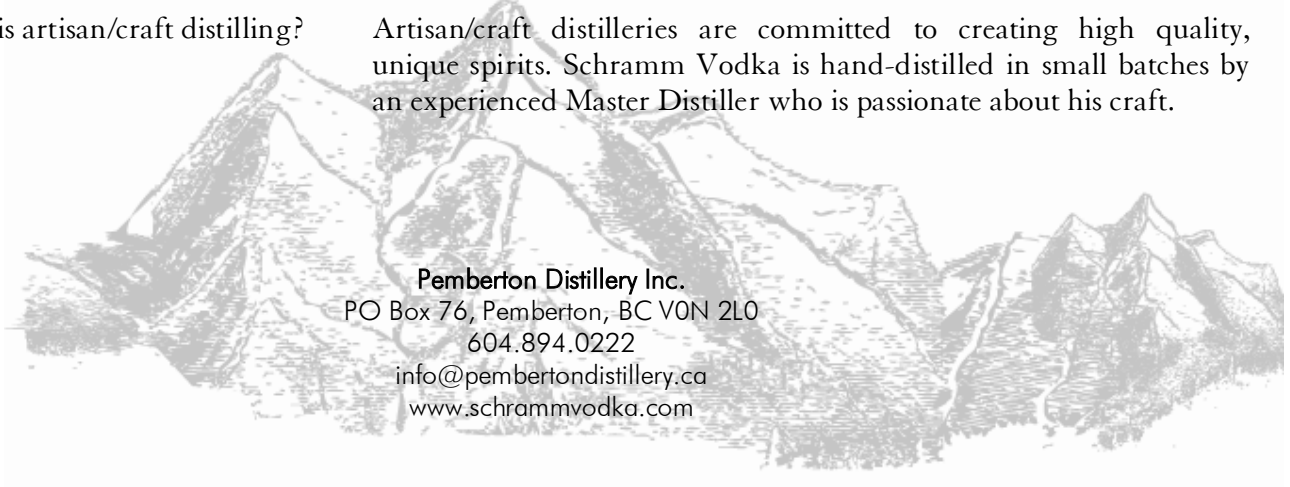

Schramm Vodka FAQ

- Is all vodka made from potatoes? No, 98% of vodka available on the world market is grain based. Potato vodka is less common due to the extra cost and handling requirements of potatoes and the increased complexity of the fermentation process.
- Does potato vodka taste different? High quality potato vodka is considered to be smoother and silkier than grain vodka. The aroma and taste of varies as well. Schramm Vodka has a subtle sweet, peppery character derived from the natural potato.
- How many potatoes are in a bottle of Schramm Vodka? Approximately 7 kg of potatoes are needed for one bottle of Schramm Vodka - roughly the size of a regular supermarket bag of potatoes.
- Does organic vodka taste different? We like to think so! We believe in the quality of organic produce and the environmental benefits of organic agriculture. As a local producer we rely on the Pemberton Valley's pristine soil and water to provide exceptional quality ingredients for our vodka.
- What is ultra premium vodka? Ultra premium vodka is carefully distilled to retain only the best spirit and to highlight the character of the raw ingredients. It is easily enjoyed neat and in fine cocktails.
- What is artisan/craft distilling? Artisan/craft distilleries are committed to creating high quality, unique spirits. Schramm Vodka is hand-distilled in small batches by an experienced Master Distiller who is passionate about his craft.
